We would like to introduce to you some new staff who have joined our team!

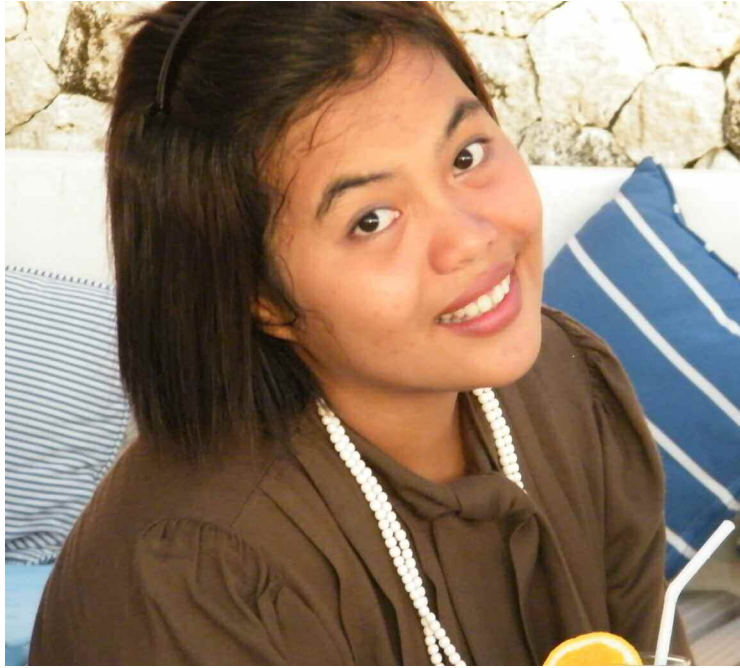
### Mai
